

# You're invited to the Greater Akron area's transportation future

The Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) invites you to join us in preparing two items key to the future of the Greater Akron area: *Transportation Outlook 2040* and the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for Fiscal Years 2018 through 2021.



*Transportation Outlook 2040* is the area's long-range transportation plan of identified needs and recommendations. The TIP is the area's four-year program of highway, public transit and bike and pedestrian projects scheduled to receive federal funding. Drafts of both items will be available for review and comment from **March 27** through **April 7** at various locations.

The agency is also hosting a public engagement meeting during which residents are encouraged to share their insights on these items. The meeting begins at **6:30 p.m., Thursday, March 30** at the **Akron-Summit County Public Library - Main Library** located at **60 South High Street** in Akron.
