This is a free, one-day-only drop-off event for household hazardous waste for County residents.

What to bring:

Adhesives	Fluorescent bulbs	Paint thinner
Aerosol cans	Gasoline	Pesticides/herbicides
Antifreeze	Gas/oil mix	Photographic chemicals
Brake fluid	Kerosene	Pool chemicals
Car batteries	Lighter fluid	Propane tanks
Cleaners	Mercury	Stains/varnishes
Drain cleaners	Motor oil/filters	Thermostats
Fire extinguishers	Paints (latex/oil)	Thermometers

Rechargeable & button cell batteries: individually bag each OR tape terminals.

Asbestos containing materials: call to pre-register, must be double bagged.

What NOT to bring:

Appliances	Empty containers	Infectious/medical waste
Alkaline batteries	Explosives/munitions	Smoke detectors
Electronics	Furniture	Tires

Residential material only.

No commercial or industrial waste. No containers over 10 gallons.
This event is offered free of charge and is for County residents only.
