The purpose of the RAB is to promote community involvement representative of interested community members as well as local, state and federal agencies. The RAB serves as a focal point for the exchange of information between Fort Bliss and the community about current and future installation restoration activities.

RAB members are expected to attend annual or semiannual RAB meetings; provide input in an open, honest and constructive manner; represent and communicate community concerns; act as a conduit for exchange of information; review and comment on documents related to environmental restoration; and serve without compensation. RAB applicants can be any community member, including local, state or federal government officials; tribal government members; non-profit organizations or other interested groups. No specific academic, professional or work experience is required. Members are asked to serve a two or three-year term.
