

GAS SAFETY INFO

Did you know gas pipelines may be located in your area? Here's how to recognize a leak.

SMELL!

Natural gas and propane are naturally odorless. A "rotten egg" odor is added for easy detection.

SEE!

Blowing dirt or bubbling creeks or ponds. Natural gas is lighter than air and rises whereas propane gas is heavier and settles.

HEAR!

Listen for hissing sounds near a gas appliance or line.

Do not smoke, light a match or do anything that may result in an explosion or fire.



FPU Emergency Response is available 24/7. If you suspect a gas leak or related emergency, LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY and call FPU at **800.427.7712**. (Or dial 911 if needed.)



Pipeline markers along mains and transmission lines have phone numbers in case of emergency. They don't show exact locations/depths, so please call 811 to locate and mark utility lines. Some segments along transmission pipelines may be designated as High Consequence Areas (HCAs). Call **800.427.7712** for FPU's Integrity Management Program.
